Released from Temporary Sunilian Representation in Urubamba, Peru

Subject: The Empire of Sunilian States' position on local unrests in Peru; Announcing a Temporary Representation of Sunilia to Peru

Ruef Sunilien!

The Empire of Sunilian States has sent a representative of the nation to work on social development projects in Urubamba, Peru. We have also set up a temporary representation of the Empire of Sunilian States in the town of Urubamba to the Republic of Peru for Sunilian Citizens or other people in the need of direct contact to the Sunilian Government.

During the early stages of this representation of Sunilia in Peru, social protests took place in the Urubamba province, with road blockades and occasional violence both from the side of the police and the side of the protesters. The Sunilian Representation was temporarily closed, a lockdown was issued for all people associated to the Sunilian Empire in Peru, and travel warnings as well as updates to the situation were issued.

These unrests were caused by several factors which included, but were not limited to the increase of electricity prices by about 200%; the fact that the road to Macchu Picchu was sold to a private company with very little profit for the local communities and the lack of action taken by the national government of Peru against plagues that endanger the local agriculture, such as the fruit flies.

These are all very reasonable concerns by the population of which the majority in this region lives around or below the poverty line. It is essential that the government of the Republic of Peru undertake measures to address these concerns. Though there has been dialogue between the government and the protesters in the most recent protests earlier this week, actual results are not yet to be seen. It was not the first time that the people protested against the lack of actions by the government, and meanwhile it overdue that the Peruvian government takes actions.

The Empire of Sunilian States supports these issues voiced by the people and will continue to engage in social development activities throughout Urubamba Province, Peru for the upcoming months.
